#### **Deployment:**

The college takes initiatives to implement the above strategic plans for better utilization of available human resources and infrastructure. Students' academic excellence, empowerment, and welfare are of prime importance when formulating the strategic plan. Events deployed include the preparation of a calendar of events, induction programs, cyclic AQAR reports, AAA, and events organized by IQAC/NSS/NCC/various departments/committees, etc.



#### Administrative setup:-

Karnatak University has established administrative strategies and instructed the Principal to implement and execute the rules and regulations to achieve the institution's goals, vision, and mission. At the college level, the administrative hierarchy is headed by the Principal, followed by the Heads of Departments (HODs) of various departments and non-teaching staff. The departmental hierarchy is led by the HOD, with headship assigned on a two-year rotation basis. If there are no permanent teaching staff in a department, the HOD or Coordinator of the parent department will oversee the department. The formal organizational structure of the library includes the Librarian, Assistant Librarian, and other subordinate staff.

Procedure for recruitment:- Karnatak Science College is a constituent college of Karnatak University, Dharwad. Permanent teaching and non-teaching positions are filled by the University following the rules set by the UGC and KCSR. Candidates are selected based on merit in all respects by the appointment committee. If a department has insufficient permanent teaching faculty, the remaining workload is distributed to temporary teaching assistants/guest faculties. These temporary positions are appointed by Karnatak University. Temporary non-teaching positions are filled on a contract basis.

Promotion of permanent teaching staff is facilitated through the Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) after fulfilling the required eligibility criteria.

**Service rules:** The service conditions of permanent teachers, including appointments and promotions, are regulated by Karnatak University, Dharwad, in accordance with the rules and regulations stipulated by the UGC and the Government of Karnataka. The service rules of non-teaching staff are governed by the Karnataka Civil Services Rules (KCSR) and the regulations set forth by the University.

#### Grievance redressal mechanism:

The institute has its own grievance redressal committee for both staff and students. The committee reviews the grievances received and resolves them promptly. Depending on the severity of the complaints, they are resolved within the time limit suggested by management. The identity of the person filing a complaint in suggestion boxes is kept confidential. The decision regarding the suggestion is communicated to the relevant committee, cell, or individual of the institute for further action.





- **ii) Induction programme:** An induction programme for newly admitted students of B.Sc., BCA, B.Sc. (CS), M.Sc. Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics was conducted on 1st December 2022 at Srujana Ranga Mandir (College auditorium). An official introduction was given about all the teachers from different departments, the various courses offered in the college, infrastructure on the campus, facilities available, responsibilities of the students, different cells in the college to monitor the students' academic progress, Health Centre facility, Banking facility, NCC, NSS, Gymkhana facilities, Students Welfare Committee, Placement Cell, and code of conduct, etc. A total of 318 students participated in this event, and it proved to be an informative and inspiring event for the newly admitted students.










#### xiv) One-day training programme for competitive examinations

He began with a saying; a bad bush is better than an open place, discourage the use of plastic, and grow plants. Also, he talked about the 'Save Soil' movement which was initiated by Sadguru, and how he took a journey of 30,000 km across 24 nations on a lone motorcycle to create awareness of the issue. Prof. G. The necessity of sensors, transducers, operating systems and sophisticated user interfaces is increasing exponentially hence any electronic device can be easily designed using embedded development board known as Arduino.

In this training, Arduino UNO open source microcontroller At Meg 328P board was used. Resource Persons, Mr. Vinayak Nayak and Mr. Avinash Kambale of Physics/Electronics Department, have trained the students to program the Arduino using C code and accessing the pins on the board via software to control the external devices. 
