

Response

Our institution upholds the tolerance and harmony towards cultural, regional, linguistic, communal, socioeconomic and other diversities among the students and staff members.

Tolerance and harmony towards Culture

The institute organizes the cultural programs under the banner of Gymkhana to promote and appreciate the cultural diversity of India.

- Enrolled students in the college are from diverse cultural backgrounds. They are brought together on a common platform to engage in various cultural activities, leading to fostering self-esteem, a sense of belonging, and respect for diverse cultures
- The Cultural Committee of our college inspires students to participate in different cultural activities such as Yuvajanotsava, singing competitions, folk group singing, mimes, dramas, skits, and traditional Karnataka festivals like Kannada Rajyostava, Dasara, etc.
- 198 students from our college participated in various cultural events organized at different levels, such as National, Inter-University South Zone, Inter-Zone Youth Festival, Inter-Collegiate, Inter-Zone, and Districts. Out of the total participants, 93 students were awarded different prizes.

Tolerance and harmony towards Regional and Linguistic

 Programs related to regional harmony are regularly celebrated in the institute, such as Dasara (state festival), Ganesh Chaturthi, Kannada Rajyoshtava, Basava Jayanti, fun week, among others.



Constitutional obligation: values, rights, duties and responsibility of citizens




Volunteers are taking oath on the occasion of constitution day.


