Specifically, the Committee ensures the effective execution of reservation policies in various aspects such as admissions to courses, hostel accommodation, appointments to teaching and non-teaching positions, allocation of quarters, and maintenance of roster registers within the college.

FUNCTIONING OF SC/ST COMMITTEE

The SC/ST Committee at Karnataka Science College, Dharwad, is committed to its mandate of promoting higher education and ensuring equitable opportunities for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. The following are the key functions of the SC/ST Committee:

- 1. Disseminate Government of India (GOI) and Commission's decisions: The Committee circulates GOI and Commission's decisions and collects information annually regarding coursewise admissions for SC/ST candidates in various courses offered by the college.
- 2. Monitor appointments and training: The Committee collects information on appointments and training of SC/ST communities in both teaching and non-teaching positions within the college.
- 3. Collect and analyze reports: The Committee collects reports and information concerning GOI orders on education, training, and employment of SC/ST candidates to inform policy development and modifications.
- 4. Prepare and transmit reports: It analyzes information on admissions, education, training, and employment of SC/ST candidates and prepares reports for transmission to relevant authorities such as the Ministry of Human Resource Development/University Grants Commission.
- 5. Address grievances: The Committee deals with representations received from SC/ST candidates regarding admission, recruitment, promotion, and other similar matters, providing necessary assistance and redressal.
- 6. Monitor remedial coaching scheme: It monitors the implementation of remedial coaching schemes aimed at supporting SC/ST students.
- 7. Serve as Grievances Redressal Committee: The Committee functions as a Grievances Redressal Committee for SC/ST students and employees of the college, assisting them in resolving academic and administrative issues.
- 8. Maintain employment register: It maintains a register for employment of SC/ST candidates in the college, ensuring representation in various posts.

 Undertake additional tasks: The Committee undertakes any other tasks assigned to promote higher education among SC/ST communities and address their economic, social, and educational deprivations.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES OF THE SC/ST COMMITTEE

Any student or employee (including contractual, casual, and temporary) of Karnataka Science College, Dharwad, can submit a written complaint to the Coordinator, SC/ST Committee. The complaint should detail the nature of the grievance and be addressed to the coordinator for appropriate action.

DROP BOX FACILITY

A Drop Box is available at the SC/ST Committee office, allowing SC/ST students and employees to securely deposit their complaints if they prefer not to submit them in person. This ensures confidentiality and accessibility in the grievance redressal process.
